Saturday will see a new initiative – a fellowship meeting joining Nepali brothers and sisters from the Midlands area with conference delegates. Together we will worship and enjoy the presence of God, in both English and Nepali.

Some of the joys of the conference weekend will be people coming together in praise and worship and getting closer to projects and programmes in Nepal, but there will also be opportunities for personal space. This could be used to reflect on what God has been saying to you, or something that has struck you in a seminar. Or it could be used renewing friendships or discovering new friendships and opportunities for service through conversation with Nepali brothers and sisters. You could of course simply enjoy a walk in the grounds of The Hayes!
