LONG TERM PLAN

To address the challenge of sustainability and to give new life to the 60 year-old infrastructure and outdated equipment, the management team of GPH has come up with a bold new plan to ensure the long term future of the hospital and its service to the people of Nepal.

GPH is heading into exciting new territory with funding approved for Phase 1 of this long term plan which aims to:

- Transform GPH into a centre of excellence for disabilities related to SCI, trauma and spinal disorders, leprosy, Ear related problems and general disability
- Develop the centre where Christian ethos, values and practices are followed for the holistic treatment of patients
- Ensure self-sustainability through expert technical human resources and promoting self-sustainable related activities within the hospital

The primary goal of Phase 1 is to upgrade the current service level of GPH through the following objectives:

- The renovation/refurbishment of infrastructure
- The purchase of up to date equipment
- The recruitment of technical experts
- The construction of a chapel within the complex
